

POOL RULES

- 1. Lifeguards and staff members are here for your safety and must be obeyed at all times.
- 2. Your membership must be checked with each visit to the pool.
- 3. Please remind children to rinse sandy feet when returning from the playground. Parents are to supervise children on the playground; use of the playground is at your own risk.
- 4. Appropriate swim attire must be worn. (No cut-offs or street clothes.)
- 5. Children ages 9 and under will **<u>NOT</u>** be admitted without a parent or caregiver (minimum age 14.)
- 6. Children ages 10 and up may come to the pool unaccompanied, if they have passed the swim test.
- 7. Children ages 9 and under who are not able to swim a length of the pool and any child wearing a flotation device must have a parent or caregiver (minimum age 14) in the pool with them or sitting within arm's reach.
- 8. All children who wish to swim in the deep end of the pool must pass the swim test to swim or be accompanied by an adult.
- 9. Children under the age of 3 are not allowed to be in the pool without a parent or caregiver (aged 14 or older). Any child aged 2 or older must vacate the pool during adult swim.
- 10. Please walk at all times on the pool deck.
- 11. Running, pushing, horseplay and abusive language will not be tolerated.
- 12. Swim masks, snorkels, noodles, kick boards and other pool toys may only be used with permission from the guards, who have the right to limit their use when it might create unsafe conditions.
- 13. Super Soakers, large rafts, dive sticks and water balloons are not allowed in the pool area.
- 14. Please do not hang on the basketball rim.
- 15. Do not throw balls across the pool.
- 16. No glass containers of any kind are allowed at pool facilities.
- 17. No outside food or drinks are allowed.
- 18. No coolers will be allowed except for bottled water, baby food or medication.
- 19. All food must be consumed away from the side of the pool.
- 20. Due to ABC laws, all alcoholic beverages consumed on club premises must be purchased from the club. The club reserves the right to inspect all coolers.
- 21. Under threatening conditions, the pool area will be cleared for 30 minutes for thunder and 1 hour for lightning. If conditions persist, the pool will close until safe conditions return.

- 22. Adult swim will be the last 15 minutes of every hour.
- 23. SHOES must be worn in the clubhouse at all times. No wet bathing suits, wet shorts or wet clothing will be allowed in the clubhouse.
- 24. Our guards will use the "3-Strike" Policy to enforce rules.
 - 1. Warning
 - 2. Time-out
 - 3. Send home for the day.

If behavior continues to be a problem, pool privileges may be suspended for a longer period of time, or the child may lose the right to come to the pool without a parent.
